

Nurturing Parenting Programs

The *Nurturing Parenting Program* is a free fourteen-week parenting program for Richmond parents, grandparents and others caring for children ages 0 – 5. *Nurturing Parenting* includes information and guidance about the physical, social, emotional and intellectual development of young children; nurturing family routines; taking care of you; choices and consequences; effective discipline; helping children manage their own behavior; plus other topics of interest to families with young children. A child's group for youngsters ages 4 – 6 and child watch for children of other ages are important parts of *Nurturing Parenting*. Group discussion, activities, books and DVD's are included in each session. *Nurturing Parenting* is offered several times each year in a variety of locations throughout the city. Participants completing the full program receive a certificate, and snacks and transportation assistance are available.
