

## **Animal (dog and cat) License FAQs**

---

### **Is a license required for my dog or cat?**

Yes. A license is required for a dog or cat.

### **When is the animal license fee due?**

The license fee is due immediately for animals at least four months old.

### **How much does a license cost for a dog or cat?**

The license fee for a dog or cat is \$10.00.

### **How long are the licenses good? Or, do they have an expiration date?**

Dog and cat licenses are good for the period January 1 – December 31. They expire each year on December 31 and a new license must be obtained by January 31 of the following year.

### **What do I need to purchase a license for my dog or cat?**

A valid rabies vaccination certificate signed by a Veterinarian licensed in the Commonwealth of Virginia.
