There will be a vigil service open to the public on Thursday December 5, 2019, at Huguenot High School located at 7945 Forest Hill Avenue, Richmond, VA 23225 from 5:30PM to 7:00PM. A public viewing will be held for Lt. Berry on Friday, December 6, 2019 at Mimms Funeral Home located at 1827 Hull Street, Richmond, VA 23224 from 9:00AM until 8:00PM. A Celebration of Life Ceremony is set to begin at noon on Saturday, December 7, 2019, at Second Baptist Church located at 3300 Broad Rock Blvd, Richmond, Virginia, 23234.
