SET UP AND CLEAN UP

Booths should be set up by 11:00 a.m. the day of the event (October 8, 2011) at Broad Rock Park, located at 4802 Warwick Road. Activities are scheduled to last from noon to 5:00 p.m., rain or shine. While some assistance may be available to you in setting up your booth, in general, participants must have the personnel necessary to unload, setup, and breakdown their own spaces. Please arrive early as the parking lot fills up fast!
