*Greetings to all,*

*March 2011 was a good month overall in crime reduction. Violent Crime was up by one crime (5/6) from last year, but Property Crime was down 24 crimes (73/49). This resulted in a Total Major Crime reduction of -29% in reported crime this year as compared to March 2010.*

*Year-to-date our Violent Crime is up 3 crimes (16/19) and our Property Crime is down 19 (177/158). **This resulted in a Total Major Crime of -8% as compared to this period in 2010.***

*Unfortunately we had one murder. This occurred at 4<sup>th</sup> & Main Street. We have not made an arrest in this case and we still need witnesses to come forward. **If you have any information in this murder please contact Crime Stoppers at 780-1000.***

*We are getting significantly better in deterring crime. The most significant reduction has been in reports of **Theft's from Motor Vehicles**. There has been an overall reduction of -42% as compared to last year. Please keep up the good work and keep your valuables out of site.*

- *While we are doing much better in securing our vehicles, there are still locations where this crime is still occurring regularly. The area around 5<sup>th</sup> & Main Street (City Center) and the area around Adams & Marshall Street (Jackson Ward).*
  - *A large amount of these victims are patrons to the bars and clubs in the area.*
  - *It usually occurs between 8:00 PM and 4:00 AM.*
