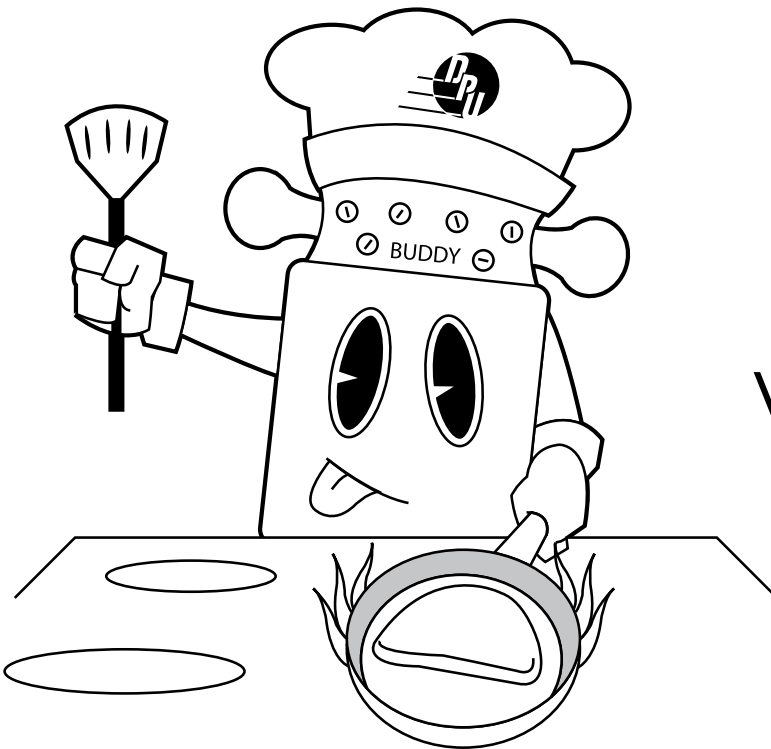
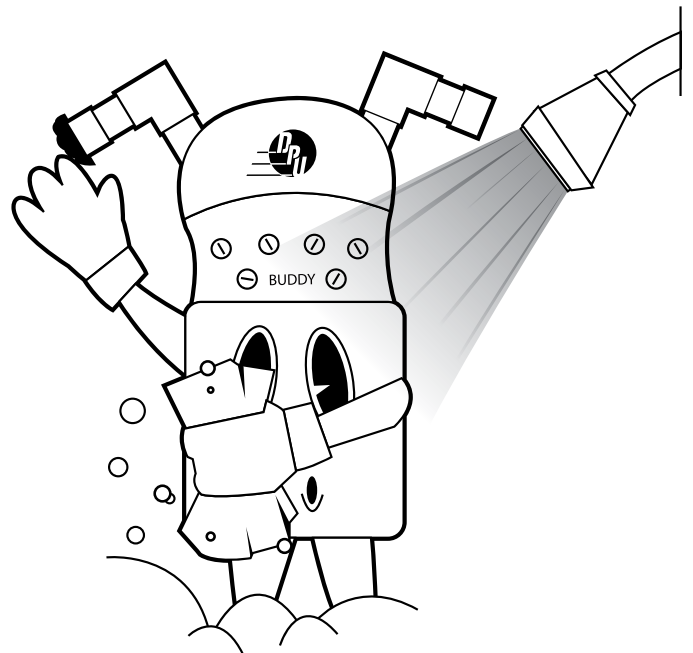
Hi, I'm Utility Buddy, your friend from the Department of Public Utilities. Come with me and I'll tell you about natural gas safety!

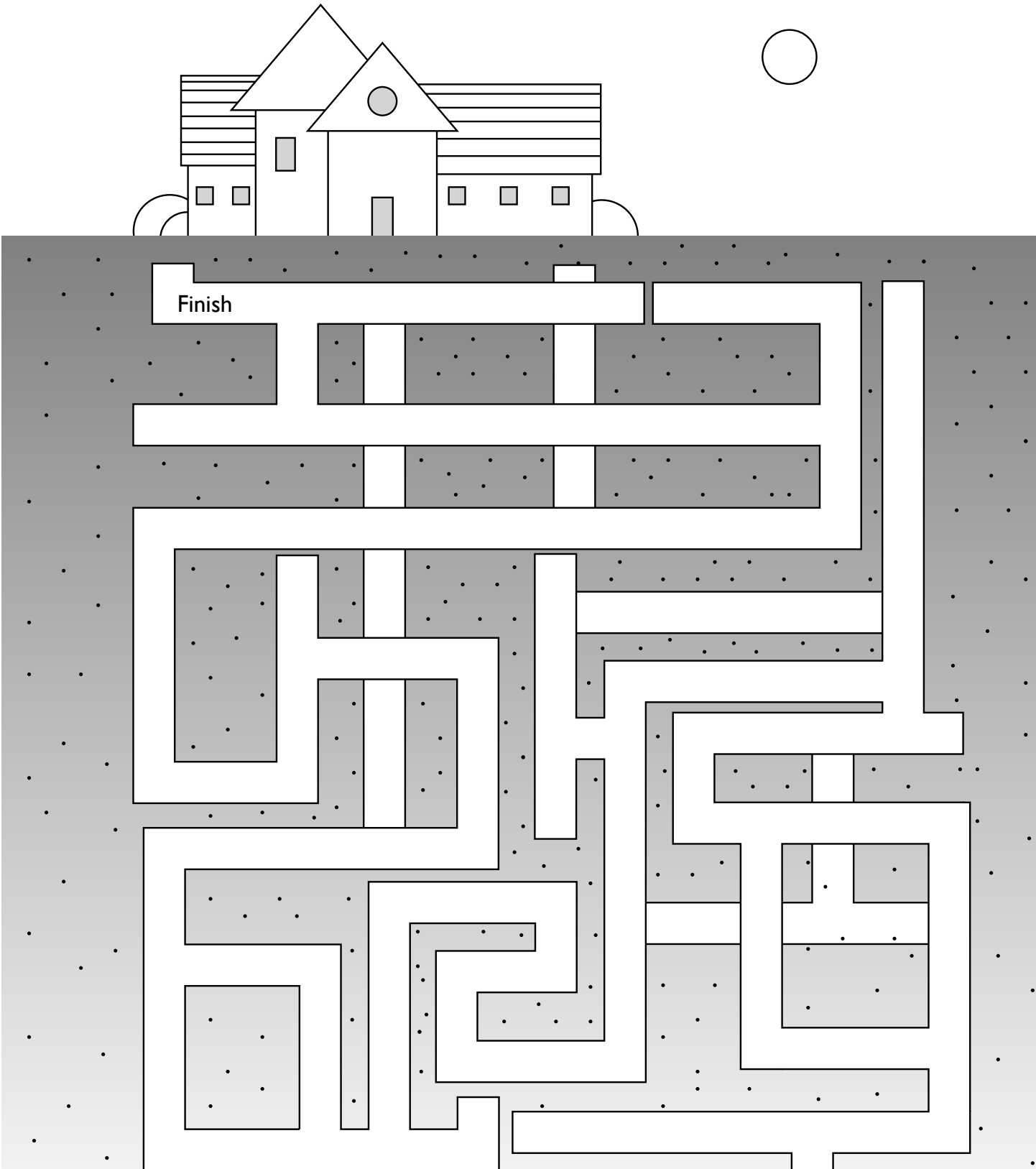


We use natural gas for fuel to heat our home...

& heat water for hot showers.



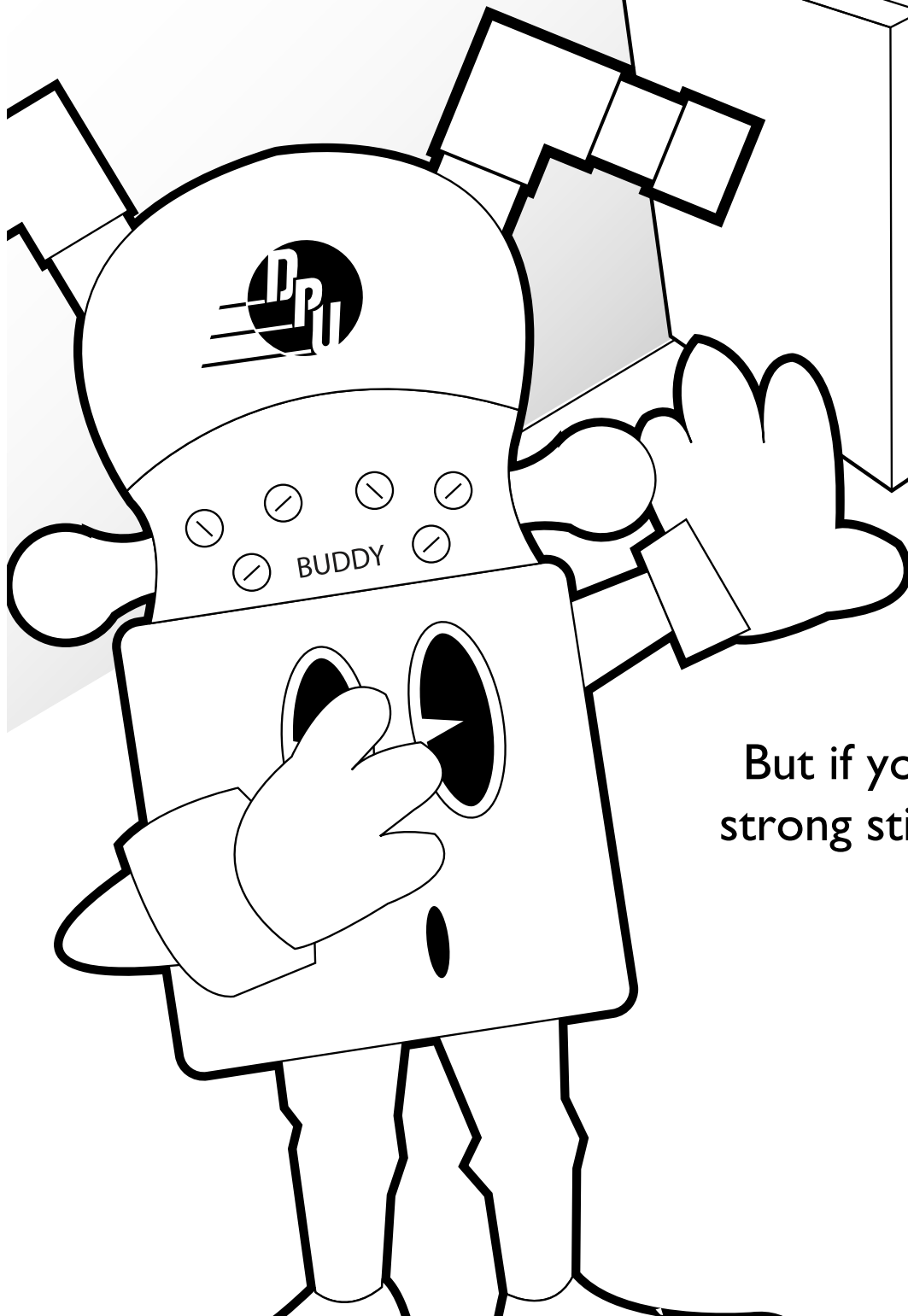
We also use natural gas to cook our food.

# Remember This...

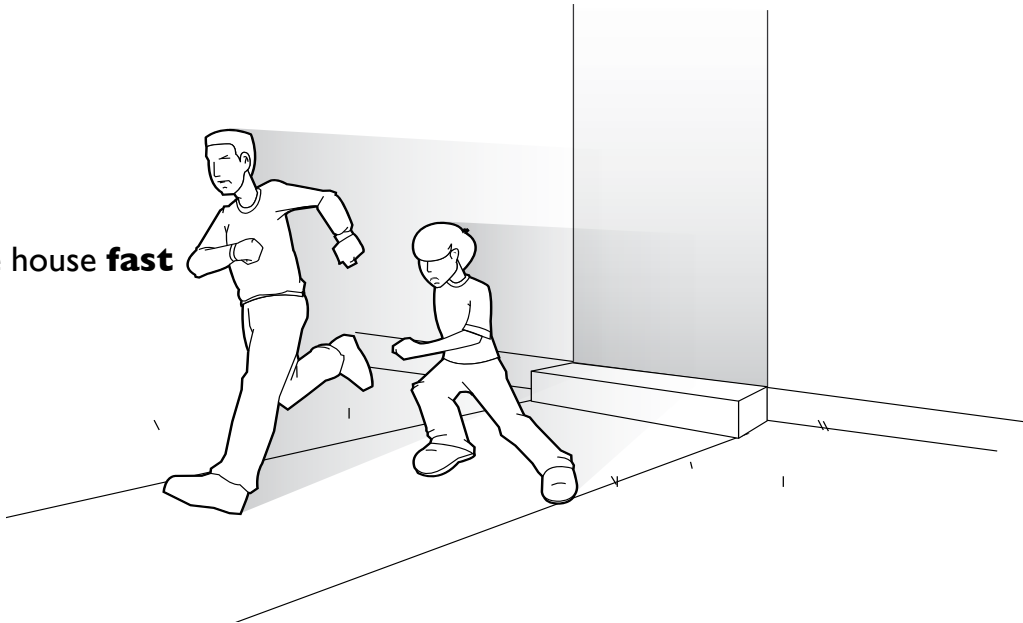


1. Don't use the telephone

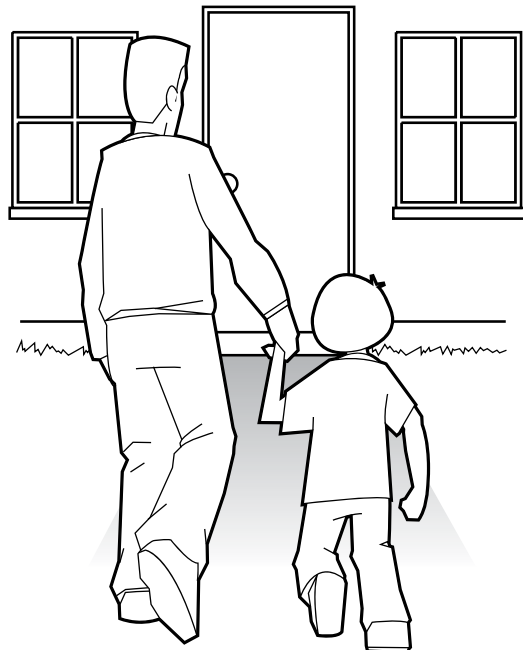


2. Don't turn lights on or off

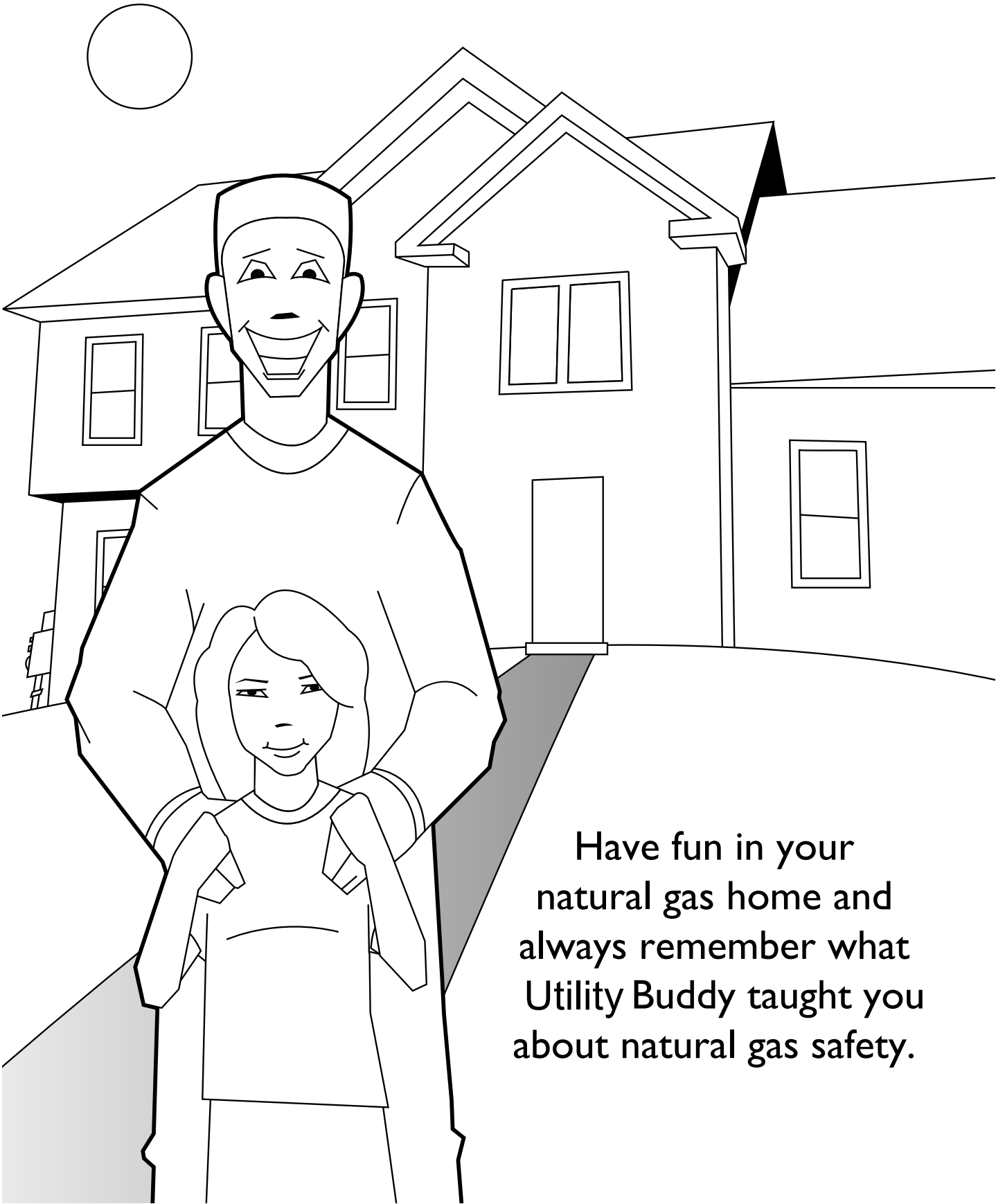
3. Leave the house **fast**

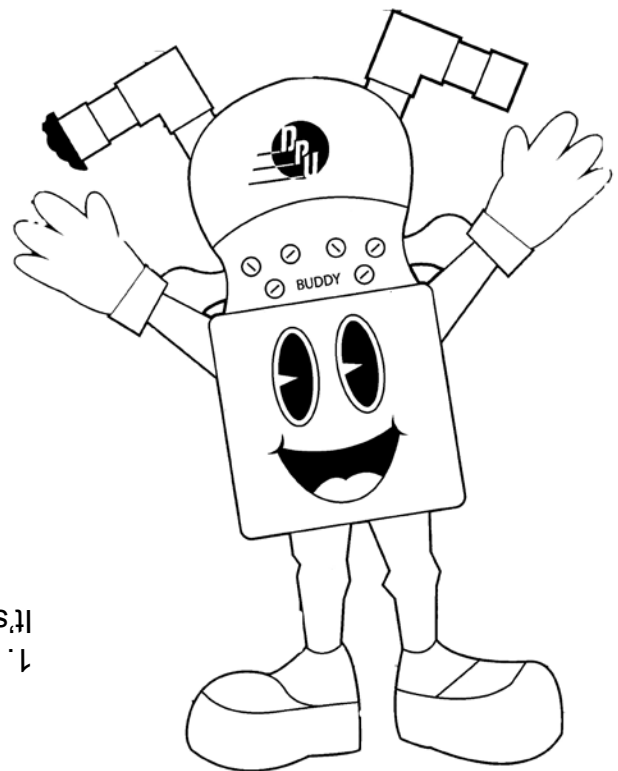
