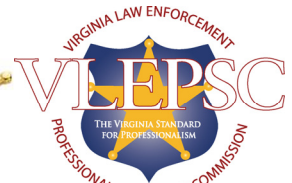

RSCO Internship Program

- Provides undergraduate college students with academic interests in criminal justice or related fields the opportunity to work as interns in various areas within the Richmond City Sheriff's Office in order to prepare them for future work opportunities in their field of interest.
- The RSCO has formed partnerships with: Virginia Union University, Spellman College, Duke University, Morehouse College, North Carolina A&T, J. Sergeant Reynolds CC, ITT and VCU. Participation in this program increased last year by **38%**.

Video Conferencing Technology

- The average number of inmates per day physically in Court 2010 = **52** (vs. 90 per day in 2006 – Pre-Video Conference).
- In 2010 we produced **4,142** individuals before judges via Video Arraignment. (CY2009 = 2,007)
- Bonds granted by the Magistrate via Video Conference Technology = **2,943**
- The Total number of all Video Conferences conducted at the Richmond City Jail = **7,533**
- The Total number of all Arraignments conducted via Video Technology during CY2010 = **7,215**

Records

- Average number of arrestees processed and released or transferred to other jurisdictions each day from the RCJ = **25**
- DNA Swabs conducted by Records personnel rose by more than 100 to **386**.
- Court Movement rose significantly in 2010 compared to 2009 (**18,469** in '10 vs. **16,554** in '09).
- Total New Commits to the RCJ = **9,094**

Training

- New Online In-Service Training Module affords deputies more opportunities to increase their knowledge
- Agency achieved first ever 100% pass rate on firearms qualifications
- Graduated **21** deputies from the 67th Basic Academy
- **4** Employees Completed Defensive Tactics Instructor School
- Trained **415** employees in First Aid/CPR/AED
- Conducted online training recertifying **170** employees



RCJ Resident Mail

The Records Department received, researched, and answered **7,752** letters from arrestee's committed to the Sheriff's custody. Considering an 8 hour work day, the man-hours associated with this task equates to more than 4 months and one week of a single officer answering mail. The officer assigned to this task averaged sending 32 responses per day.
